Future Affordable Senior Housing



The need for affordable senior housing grows exponentially as increasing numbers of "Baby Boomers" retire. PCH is working diligently to meet that need. We currently have a project approved by the Town of Perinton at 2770 Baird Road and are awaiting state funding for the first phase. We've already received a NYSER-DA award of \$1 million for the "net zero" energy design for the main building that will contain 76 affordable senior apartments, about half designated for "frail elderly" who need a little help with daily tasks to thrive living independently.

Senior Living Council Update

The trailblazing Fairport/Perinton Senior Living Council, Inc. that started in the 1980's as a joint venture of the Village of Fairport, Town of Perinton, and Perinton Churches Housing, Inc. is now operated by Fairport Baptist Homes Caring Ministries, Inc. (FBH). This vital program that provides transportation, affordable housing, and care managers for Perinton seniors grew so big it needed to be professionally managed. We're grateful that FBH continues the good work.

Fairport Apartments opened its doors on the campus of Fairport Baptist Homes in 1972 and is jointly-owned by Fairport Baptist Homes (52%) which manages the apartments and PCH (48%).
